Academic Scholars Award – Recipient must be a freshman with a high school GPA of 3.0/4.0 scale.

Alabama Dairy Springer Scholarship – Undergraduate pursuing a degree in business administration or biology.

Leola Sanders Alexander Annual Scholarship – Student must have a GPA of 2.5.

John & Eloise Archer Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted students from Pike County who are members of the boys or girls basketball team. Recipients must not be receiving any other type of athletic scholarship from TROY. Student must be of good character, have demonstrated leadership ability and have 18 ACT & 2.3 GPA.

Robert & Mildred Blount Scholarship – Awarded to the most outstanding high school seniors from Elmore County.

Elbert Botts Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted students or currently enrolled TROY students with at least a 2.0 GPA who are majoring in Geomatics or Business.

Jennifer Wright Bowdin Memorial Scholarship – Female students who have graduated from Samson High School and have a 3.0 GPA and 18 ACT. Applicants should have lettered in one or more of the following sports: basketball, volleyball, or softball. Recipients will be required to work on campus and must be a TROY sophomore, junior or senior.

Jessie Floyd-Braswell Scholars Award – Unconditionally admitted students or currently enrolled TROY students who have a 2.0 GPA. Awards are based on financial need and academic achievement.

Claude Allen Brown Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted students or currently enrolled TROY students who are majoring in Pre-Engineering. Recipients must have graduated from Charles Henderson High School with a minimum 3.0 GPA. If a student from Charles Henderson High School cannot be identified from the above criteria, a student may be selected from any high school located in Pike County.

Woodrow and Dessie Carter – Students pursuing majors in the College of Business.

Mildred Brown Davis Scholarship – Currently enrolled TROY juniors, seniors, and graduate students who have a 3.3 GPA. Recipients must maintain a 3.3 GPA.

Dacre Green Davis Environmental Science Scholarship – Students majoring in Environmental Science who have a minimum 2.0 GPA and agree to pursue a career in Environmental Science in the State of Alabama. Recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA and agree to a work requirement in the Center for Environmental Service.

Paul Drennan Charitable Foundation Scholarship – Student must have financial need. Preference is given to students from Goshen, Glenwood and Luverne with a 2.0 GPA.

Curtis & Lillian Dunning Endowed Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted or currently enrolled TROY students with at least a 2.0 GPA who are graduates of Seminole County High School in Georgia.

Millie Huff Ezell Scholarship – Recipients must be residents of either Pike, Coffe, Crenshaw, Bullock, Barber, or Dale county with preference given to those students pursuing majors within the School of Education. Freshman applicants must have an ACT score of at least 20 and current Univeristy students must have a grade point average of 3.0/4.0.

Allan B. Fountain Art Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted students who are majoring in Art.

Anna & Seymour Gitenstein Endowed Scholarship – Incoming students who are unconditionally admitted with at least a 2.0 GPA who are residents of Covington County (AL) or Walton County (FL). Recipients must maintain academic good standing and agree to a work assignment consistent with their field of study.

Mary F. Hamilton Scholarship – Undergraduate or Graduate student pursuing a major in Early Childhood or Elementary Education. Must be a Sophomore, Junior or Senior with a 2.6 GPA. Graduate student must have a 3.0 GPA.

Martha Reddoch Harlin Memorial Scholarship – Students majoring in education who have at least a 2.0 GPA.

Jack Hawkins, Jr., Endowed Leadership Scholarship – Recipient must have demonstrated strong leadership characteristics in their school, community, and/or other activities. Must have a GPA of 3.0 and submit a one-page letter describing their leadership roles and service to the community.

J.H. and Winnie T. Hollis Scholarship – Recipient must be a graduate of Brantley High school. If a Brantley graduate is not eligible then the scholarship may be awarded to other Crenshaw County high school students. Recipient must maintain a 2.5/4.0 GPA.

Roscoe and Mattie Howard Scholarship – Recipient must be a junior majoring in business or education with a 2.5/4.0 GPA. Recipient must be of the Christian faith.

Earl Hutto Foundation Scholarship – Student must be pursuing a major in Nursing.

Roy E. and Mable Jeffcoat Scholarship – Students who have a 2.5 GPA majoring in education. Preference is given to students from Pike County.

Terry Edward and Roland Riley Johnson Memorial Scholarship – Students who have a 2.5 GPA and 20 ACT. Available to entering freshmen and currently enrolled TROY students who are from Covington County. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Dr. Emmett Kilpatrick Perpetual Memorial Fund – Currently enrolled students with a 3.0 GPA and 23 ACT or entering freshmen with a 3.0 GPA and 25 ACT. Recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Byron Lee Perpetual Memorial Fund Scholarship – Currently enrolled students must have a 23 ACT and a 2.5 GPA and entering freshmen must have a 24 ACT and a 3.0 GPA.

Dr. Phillip J. Levine Endowed Scholarship – Recipient must be majoring in Criminal Justice.

Dorsey Bishop Melton, Sr. Scholarship – Recipient must be a junior or senior. Recipient or recipient's family must be an Alabama resident. Award is only for one year. Recipient may not reapply.

Hennigan/Morris Scholarship Fund – Undergraduate junior or senior students with a minimum 2.5 GPA who are majoring in Elementary or Secondary Education.

Alice D. Moseley Endowment Scholarship – Currently enrolled students with a 2.5 GPA or entering freshmen with a 3.0 GPA. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Lynn Deppen Patterson Scholarship – Awarded to students who have graduated from either Luverne or Brantley High School. Minimum 2.5 GPA and a 20 ACT. Applicant must submit three letters of recommendation from high school teachers and principals. Preference is given to students recognized for their leadership skills.

Neal Nichols Scholarship – Students from Coffee County High School with a 3.0 GPA and a 19 ACT or better.

Hugh Vernon Quarles – Unconditionally admitted male students from Pike County who are of good character and have demonstrated leadership ability and community involvement. Recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

Larkin L. Reese Scholarship – Currently enrolled students must have a 23 ACT and an overall 2.5 GPA. Incoming freshman recipients must have at least a 24 ACT and a 3.0 GPA.

Hugh G. Rose Scholarship – Currently enrolled TROY students or entering freshmen with a 3.0 GPA. A short essay propounding the tangible and intangible benefits of the free enterprise system must accompany the application for this scholarship. Recipients must be residents of Alabama with preference given to residents of Covington County. Recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Seay, Seay, & Litchfield Scholarship – Awarded to students who have declared a major in the College of Business who are enrolling in Troy University as a freshman with a GPA of 3.5 and/or an ACT of 22 or currently enrolled with a GPA of 3.5.

Alfred L. Shell Endowed Scholarship – Unconditionally admitted graduates of Excel High School in Monroe County, AL., Recipients must demonstrate financial need, be of good character, and be recommended by a high school faculty member.

Blanche Reynolds Solomon Scholarship – Currently enrolled TROY students with a 2.5 GPA and 18 ACT or entering freshmen must have a 3.0 GPA and 18 ACT. Preference is given to: 1. Headland High School graduates 2.) Other Henry County high school graduates 3.) Other South Alabama high school graduates. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Joe R. and Barbara Sport Endowed Scholarship – Scholarships will be used to benefit Troy University students who graduated from a public school in Crenshaw County, Alabama. Must have strong work ethics and demonstrate good citizenship, attitude and integrity. GPA 2.5.

Patricia Stark Nursing Scholarship – Students majoring in nursing.

Cathy Lynn Stewart Scholarship – Students majoring in political science-related areas: history, government, or criminal justice. Currently enrolled TROY students must have a 2.0 GPA and 22 ACT. Entering freshmen must have a 2.0 GPA and 23 ACT. Recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

A.W. & Florence Tate Scholarship – Entering freshmen must have a 3.0 GPA and 23 ACT. Awards are given to Dale County high school graduates only. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA and reside in Dale County.

Frances Sanders Tidwell Scholarship – Incoming Freshman, native of Pike County. Students must be education or English majors. Recipient must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Bertie Clark Cain and Veta Ross Tootle Scholarship – Recipient must be majoring in nursing or education. Recipient must maintain a 2.5/4.0 scale.

Troy University Student Government Association Scholarship – Currently enrolled TROY students who have a 2.7 GPA, 3 letters of recommendation from TROY faculty, and have served 2 academic terms with the Troy SGA as a Senator, Supreme Court Justice, or other elected or appointed office.

Majorie H. Turner Scholarship – Students from Crenshaw and/or Pike counties. Must be pursuing a degree in the College of Education.

Anne Wood Johnson – recipients must be a full-times student at TROY.

Brian Stroud Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship is for Goshen High School graduate who are entering TROY as a freshman with at least a 3.0 GPA and 16 ACT.

Carol Butterworth Endowed Scholarship – Students majoring in education from Shelby County. Recipient must have financial need, be a rising sophomore with a GPA of at least 2.5.

Dr. Al. Kirby Endowed Scholarship – Recipient must be pursuing a career in the sciences, including the teaching of science. Must be enrolled full-time with a 3.0 GPA and be from Coffee County, AL.

Jim Stephens Scholarship – Incoming freshman, 3.0 GPA & 19 ACT. Must be pell grant eligible, full-time student and resident of Alabama. Recipients are required to accept a work-study assignments. Renewable up to 4 years.

Johnston/Colley Scholarship – Currently enrolled students must have a 2.6 GPA, incoming freshman must have a 2.4 GPA. Recipient must be from Pike County.

Parmer Education Scholars Scholarship – Students who are residents of Alabama and pursuing a degree in Education with at least a 3.0 GPA.

Sherlock Smith & Adams Scholarship – Recipient must be enrolled full-time and be pursuing a degree in the Sorrell College of Business.

Wachovia Foundation Endowed Scholarship – Recipient must be female and enrolled full-time at TROY.

William R. Hudson- Recipients must be graduate of a Pike County School with a 2.5 GPA. Applicants must provide reference letters from high school guidance counselor, personal friend, and a community leader.

Earl and Carol Franks Scholarship – Incoming student from Luverne High School who possess a strong work ethic, selfless dedication and has a good attitude and integrity.

Ethel Hitchcock Griffin & Michael Redmon Endowed Scholarship – Recipient must be full-time student from Enterprise, AL. Must be an education major with a 2.5 GPA.

Gregory Glenn Riley Scholarship – Recipient must be a Psychology major, enrolled full-time and have a 2.8 GPA.

Herbert and Margaret Moore Scholarship - Scholarship is to assist African-American students that are pursuing a major in the College of Business from South Alabama. Recipient must have minimum GPA of 3.0.

Williams Masonic Lodge Scholarship – Recipient must be from the Phenix City/Columbus Georgia area, majoring in education, have financial need and have GPA of 2.5.

Car Tag Scholarship – Awarded to first time TROY students (incoming students, adult learners, transfer students only). Applicant and/or parent must be a paid member of the Alumni Association at least one full year prior to application deadline. Recipient must have minimum 3.0 GPA. Recipient or family member must possess a TROY car tag, proof of receipt must be attached to scholarship application.
